Dear praying friends,

I know the Christmas season has passed, but I want to share one thought that has stuck in my mind. In Matthew 2:11 God tells us that the wise men fell down and worshipped Jesus. Mark 15:16-19 is part of the account of Jesus' trial and treatment by the Roman soldiers. We are told that the soldiers were "bowing their knees and worshipped" Jesus. One group worshipped in fervent sincerity; the other out of mocking scorn. God should be worshipped, but yet, how many people really know what that spirit of worship looks like? "O come. After being officially approved by GFA at the end of April to return to Cameroon as a career missionary, I began the necessary preparations to start deputation. I am also praying that God would knit the hearts of those pastors and congregations, with whom I am to be an extension, to mine and the needy field of Cameroon. Please pray with me.
